Swedish sign language

This is a material aimed at supporting sign language teachers in assessing their students in SSL. The material is made up of three parts: both filmed and written components.

1) Film: assessing SSL (35 min.)

Languages: SSL and a speaker text in Swedish. Graphics in Swedish.

In the first part the work of a number of students creating their own texts, their response to other texts and the assessment discussion of the teachers is shown.

The context is 10th grade in Special needs and education school, a school form aimed at students who are deaf or hard-of-hearing. This means that the students are all first language speakers of Sign, though their skills vary. The curriculum is made up of two levels, beginner and intermediate, and both are used in the film.

All students follow the same curriculum and so were given the same assignment. When assessing the teachers use performance standards for both beginner and intermediate, depending on which student they're assessing.

2) Booklet: assessing SSL

Language: Swedish

The second material deepens and broadens the film on assessment. In it the planning phase is described, and it also contains a closer description of the different parts of the film including the teacher discussion. The students work in relation to the performance standards in the curriculum is also described.

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3) Film: Lecture by Gudrun Erickson (9 min.)

Languages: Swedish interpreted into SSL. PP slides in Swedish

The third part is a filmed lecture by Gudrun Erickson, Gothenburg University, about formative assessment.
